



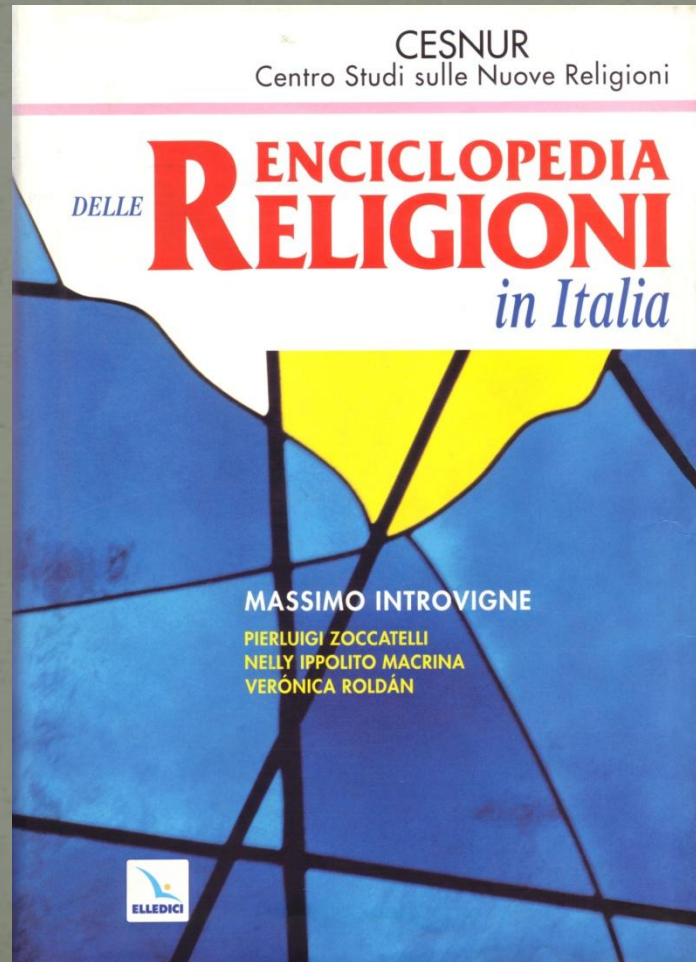

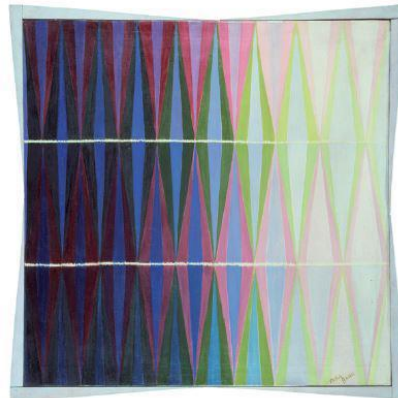



Italy 2013 — An overview

- Italian citizens = 55,961,764
- Italian resident population = 60,820,764
- Immigrants = 4,859,000 (8.0%)
- Religious minorities among Italian citizens = 1,417,000 (2.5%)
- Religious minorities including immigrants = 4,635,400 (7.6%)
- Religious and spiritual minorities = 836
